

Mathis begins stadium building

Materials

French wood specialist Mathis is working on the perfect preparation for the World Cup 2022. Mathis has spent 130 years building its business across the Middle East, Europe, Africa, North America and China, but its latest project is the building of the new Stadium in Furiani on the French island of Corsica.

The stadium has a total surface area of 6,000m² and is designed with a length of cantilever of 27m. The company describes the demanding design as exceptional, but it could provide the ideal basis for the projects relating to the World Cup 2022.

Mathis provides wooden constructions and structures as well as in timber laminate-

stuck and glued-laminated wood. With environmental responsibility a major concern in Qatar's development, Mathis is keen to emphasise that the only naturally durable and renewable material, is wood, is a pertinent building solution for nature conservation. Mathis' constructions contribute to sustainable development by meeting the objectives of the High Environmental Quality (HEQ), the French label LEED equivalent.
